Major interstate highways move goods to every major city in the Western Hemisphere. I-75 begins at the Canadian border with northern Michigan and runs to South Florida. I-94 starts at Michigan's eastern border with Canada and goes through both Detroit and Chicago on its way to the West Coast.

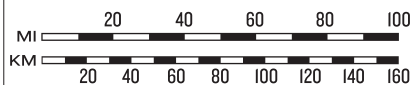
All Michigan highways are toll free.
